# Elk Island Wild Organizational Meeting May 9 2022

# Topics Discussed:

Jerseys: Barclay asked what was the pricing on them

- Haven't gotten paperwork on them from Sylvia, need to decide if we want silk screened or stitched crest (silk screen slightly cheaper but if there's no difference, go with crest)
- o Jen- can numbers be silk screened?
- o Lisa- do we need #'s on the arms?
- Jersey Sponsorship sold as lifetime sponsorship with these jerseys
  - Silk screening company logos/names will be better at bottom of jersey rather than crest
  - 4 jersey sponsors so far: Richardson Pioneer Lamont, Lamont Value Drug Mart, OK Tire Lamont and Servus Credit Union
  - Richardson and OK Tire sponsored both home and away jerseys, Value
     Drug Mart one set of jerseys and Servus \$500
- o Discussion on sponsorships and waiting on team numbers
  - Name bars will be left to teams to decide
  - Price for socks, discussion if families or association will purchase socks for players
  - \*Lisa put motion that the association purchase socks. Tom seconded, all were in favour and motion carried.
  - JJ brought up that McDonalds sponsors one set of U11 jerseys and the kids get to keep them.
  - Ashley will look into McDonald's sponsoring
- Discussion on ordering jerseys for U13, U15 and U18; should the association purchase all 'sizes' or split sizes for U13 and U15?
  - \*JJ put motion to buy sizes for the 3 teams, Jason seconded, all in favour and motion carried.

- JJ informed group that Lamont will have in September 16<sup>th</sup> (projected date) and Bruderheim is planning for the middle of October

- Barclay brought up the idea of conditioning camps for players (power skating and coach development)
  - 5 teams for 20 hours will cost the association \$5500
  - Looking at evening program and probably Saturday
  - \*Barclay put forward motion to do it, Jen seconded, all in favour and motion carried.
- Brittney Miller willing to come out every second week in Bruderheim to cut down on travel.
  - \*Barclay put motion forward to do power skating for 2022/2023 year, Jason seconded, all in favour and motion carried.

#### U7 Practice Times

 Discussed survey results about U7 ice times; discussion on staying with 1 or going back to 2 practices a week.

\*Barclay motioned to go back to 2 practices a week, Joanne seconded. Motion passed.

- o Barclay asked if ice rentals will be increasing; JJ said Lamont will increase in the new year, Bruderheim will be increasing fees as well
